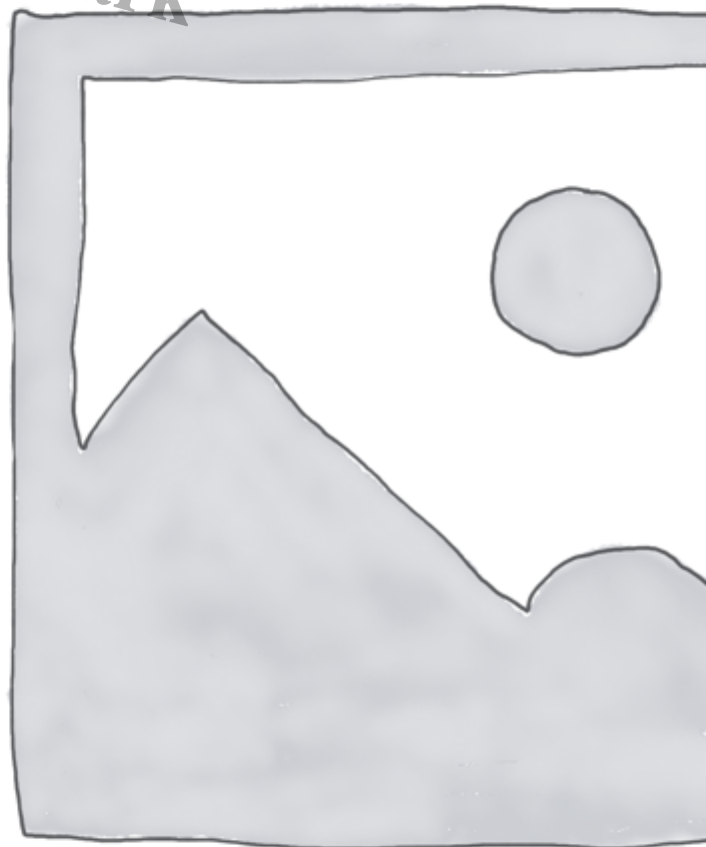
Elisabeth Yeung
