Ultrasound Evaluation form

Section 1. Ultrasound self-efficacy and confidence AFTER the ultrasound course.

I am able to perform a basic systematic ultrasound examination of the neck.

- I can identify normal anatomical structures during head and neck ultrasound. I can identify pathological lymph nodes on ultrasound
- I can distinguish common benign from suspicious ultrasound findings.
- I can use ultrasound findings as part of my clinical decision-making.
- I can judge when ultrasound findings require supervision or further imaging
- I feel confident handling the ultrasound probe and obtaining interpretable images. I feel confident using ultrasound in my routine ENT practice.
- I feel able to plan an ultrasound-guided fine-needle aspiration procedure.
- I feel able to perform an ultrasound-guided fine-needle aspiration procedure. I feel able to explain ultrasound findings to a senior colleague or supervisor. I feel able to use ultrasound in a more focused and structured way than I currently do.

Section 2. Perceived barriers (AFTER the course).

Limited access to ultrasound equipment is a barrier to my use of ultrasound.

- Lack of time in daily clinical work is a barrier to my use of ultrasound.
- Lack of supervision is a barrier to my use of ultrasound.
- I am uncertain about when ultrasound should be used in ENT practice.
- I am uncertain about how to interpret ultrasound findings.
- I do not have enough opportunities to practice ultrasound.
- The organization of my department makes it difficult to use ultrasound.
- I worry about missing pathology if I perform ultrasound myself.
- I find ultrasound-guided FNA too difficult to implement in my current setting.

Section 3. Relevance and motivation AFTER the course.

Head and neck ultrasound is relevant to my daily clinical practice.

Ultrasound-guided fine-needle aspiration is an important competency for ENT doctors.
 I am motivated to increase my use of ultrasound.
 Using ultrasound myself could reduce the need for referral to radiology in selected cases.

Section 4. Intention to implement AFTER the course

I expect to use head and neck ultrasound more frequently in the next 3 months.
 I expect to use ultrasound-guided fine-needle aspiration more frequently in the next 3 months. I expect to refer fewer patients for radiology-performed ultrasound in the next 3 months. I have a concrete plan for how to apply ultrasound in my clinical work after this course.
