We look forward to reviewing your poster at the symposium. Posters should be submitted one month before the event.

### **Poster presentation guidelines**

#### **Poster layout**

- Dimensions: A0: 118.9 cm (height) x 84.1 cm (width), portrait format
- Poster dimensions should not exceed 90×120 cm – width/height
- State the title and the authors at the top of your poster in easily readable bold letters
- Indicate the presenting author if different from the first author
- Disclose your potential conflicts of interest
- The text and the illustrations should be readable from a distance of 2 meters

#### **Preparing a Poster**

**Format:** follows that of an oral scientific presentation and includes Abstract, Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions; Recommendations.

A poster, like an oral presentation, cannot (and should not) contain all information you have on the topic. Scientific posters should stimulate interest rather than provide a detailed presentation. If all text is kept to a minimum (1000 words), a person should fully read your poster in less than 10 minutes.

Use short sentences, simple words, and bullets to illustrate your points.

Text should be broken up by including graphics or photos.

Self-explanatory graphics should dominate the poster. The success of a poster directly relates to the clarity of your illustrations and tables.

Use a non-serif font (e.g., Arial) for the poster.

#### **The presence of authors at their posters**

The presence of authors at their posters will be required only during the lunch breaks.

All accepted posters will be displayed for the 2 days of the symposium.

#### **Poster Service**

We are happy to provide you a poster-print-service for the cost of the printing (500 danish kroner). However, you will need to electronically send the poster to us no later than 14 days before the first day of the symposium.
